God's word is not intended to be merely informational, but transformational. Experience transformation in your own life by making this weekend's message real and relevant on an everyday basis. Begin by getting together with family or friends, looking up today's Bible references and interacting on the following.—Doug

1. Group: In our culture, who do people say Jesus is?

How has the media portrayed Jesus in recent years?

2. Individual/Group: Take an informal survey of colleagues at work, in the neighborhood, and among your family asking, "In your understanding, who is Jesus Christ?" Share your findings with your group. What did you learn from this experience? Were the responses encouraging or discouraging to you? Why?

3. Individual: Reflect on each one of the letters of the acrostic C.H.R.I.S.T. between Monday and Saturday. Collect your thoughts on Saturday and come to worship either Saturday night or Sunday morning ready to offer your heart to God in worship.
