1. Great delight in God and His commandments *Psalm 112:1-2*

2. Great devotion to your neighbor *Romans 12:10*

3. Pass it on *Deuteronomy 6:4-7; Psalm 78:5-8*

Teach them to:

- a. place their confidence in God
 - b. not forget the works of God
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4. Challenge: Dads, what is your vision for your kids?
 - start a walk with God
 - join with other men who are walking with God (**M**en in **T**raining at LSCC)
 - model the way by personal involvement (“the Jesus way”) with your child in LSCC Sunday school and Student Ministry *Mark 3:13-14*
 - persevere, encourage, exhort and be patient *Galatians 6:10*
